Genoa 'non-motorized' trail project proposed

The Genoa Foothill Trail System is a proposed non-motorized trail project by the Carson Valley Trails Association (CVTA) located in the Carson Range of the Sierras near Genoa.

This trail system would include an 11-mile trail from the future Adams Canyon Trailhead to Old Kingsbury Grade, traversing the mountains 1,000-1,500 feet above Genoa. A 2-mile trail would connect directly to this traversing trail from the town of Genoa. An additional 8-mile trail would connect to the Tahoe Rim Trail near Genoa Peak.

The CVTA has received a \$396,378 Question 1 Grant from the Nevada Division of State Lands to fund a majority of the trail construction for this project area. The U.S. Forest Service has recently begun required environmental

impact studies. Future public input meetings will be held for feedback and comments.

This project would implement a portion of the 2003 Douglas County

Comprehensive Trails Plan and fulfill objectives within the CVTA strategic plan. This is a cooperative effort between the CVTA, Douglas County, U.S. Forest Service, Town of Genoa, private landowners and businesses, the general public and many others.
