

MORMON STATION PARK EVENTS

Mormon Station State Park museum is open Wednesday through Sunday from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. through the middle of October. There is a \$1 entry fee per person and kids 12 & under are free.

JUNE

Wednesday, June 15th Young Chautauqua, 5–7 p.m. — FREE

Local youth portray a variety of characters from the past, including Harriet Beecher Stowe, Cattle Kate, Martha Reed, Belle Starr, Snowshoe Thompson and Queen Zninga of Angola.

Saturday, June 18th Sierra Nevada Living History Program, 10 a.m.–4 p.m. — FREE

Enjoy a day of Dutch-oven cooking demonstrations, corn husk doll making, pioneer games, musket and cannon firing, and examples of tools used by early settlers.
