THE GENOA PEAK MADATHON BENEFIT RUN

The Genoa Peak Madathon, a trail marathon and half marathon, will be held on August 10, 2013, in a fundraising effort for the Carson Valley Trails Association. In support of this event, Nixon Street will be closed that day to through traffic.

Other road closures include Jacks Valley Road from the town center north to Centennial Road. Closure times will be from 5:55 a.m. to 6:10 a.m., and from 6:25 a.m. to 6:40 a.m., to

accommodate for the marathon and half marathon starts respectively.

The course will take runners starting on the West side of Mormon Station State Park north on Jacks Valley Road. Runners will then turn left onto Centennial Road continuing north until it dead ends. From there they will cross over on an emergency access road to Eagle Ridge Road. The course will then climb Eagle Ridge Road leading them to the North trail head

for the Discovery Trail.

After two miles on the Discovery Trail, runners will continue uphill on the Sierra Canyon Trail with the half mad runners turning around just a few miles up the trail while the completely mad runners continue all the way to the summit of Genoa Peak.

All runners then return via the Discovery Trail and Genoa Canyon Trail to the finish at Genoa Park.
